WHAT? ROM. 8:23. ADOPTION = REDEMPTION EPH. 1:5-7 (ROM. 3:24-25, 5:9-10)

WHO? ROM. 9:4 ISRAEL - GAL. 3:7, 29. ROM. 4:13, 9:8

WHEN? LUKE 21: 25-33 - 6TH SEAL. MATT. 24:29. REV. 6:12

HOW? GAL. 4:1-3 | UNDER TUTORS & GOVERNORS (FOR TEACHING) UNTIL THE TIME APPOINTED OF THE FATHER. EPH. 4:11-15.

ADOPTION = HUIOTHESIA (GREEK). THE PLACING OF A SON. ADOPTION. SONSHIP IN RESPECT TO GOD, ADOPTION OF CHILDREN, OF SONS.

HUIOS (GREEK) A SON, USED VERY WIDELY OF KINSHIP. CHILD, FOAL.

THEO (GREEK) TO PLACE, IN A PASSIVE OR HORIZONTAL POSTURE. ADVISE, APPOINT, BOW, COMMIT, CONCEIVE, GIVE, KNEEL DOWN, LAY ASIDE, LAY DOWN, LAY UP, MAKE, ORDAIN, PURPOSE, PUT, SET, SET FORTH, SETTLE, SINK DOWN.

HUIOTHESIA TRANSLATED ADOPTION 3 TIMES, ADOPTION OF CHILDREN 1, ADOPTION OF SONS 1.

ADOPTION, ROM. 8:15, 8:23, 9:4, GAL. 4:5, EPH. 1:5

REDEMPTION = APOLUTROSIS, AP-OL-OO'-TRO-SIS, RANSOM IN FULL, RIDDANCE, SALVATION, DELIVERANCE, REDEMPTION.

APO- (GREEK) AS A PREFIX IT USUALLY DENOTES SEPARATION, DEPARTURE, CESSATION, COMPLETION, REVERSAL.

LUTRON (GREEK) SOMETHING TO LOOSEN WITH, REDEMPTION PRICE, ATONEMENT, RANSOM.

LUO, (GREEK) TO LOOSEN, TO BREAK UP, DESTROY, DISOLVE, UNLOOSEN, MELT, PUT OFF.
